## Water Temperature -The Key to Maintaining your Pond

With cool nights and warm days, your pond's water temperature fluctuates more than at any other time of year. Good maintenance at this time is essential to reducing algae, and controlling the healthiness of your plants and fish.

24°C

Increase lily, lotus and marginal plant feedings to twice a month

18°C

Introduce tropical plants to your pond

15°C

Start feeding potted plants with food tablets montly

13°C

Add submerged plants, such as Hornwart(Hardy) with tropical Parrot Feather. Begin feeding plants

7°C

Move existing pond plants to proper position and re-pot if necessary

Above 29°C

18°C - 21°C

Increase circulation

Switch to Summer Staple Pond Food

11°C

Begin regular use of Pond Zyme

Start water pumps. Begin testing pond water. Start biological filter
